Re: Spring Report of the LAUC Diversity Committee

The Committee received its charge in March and has since been in communication via e-mail. There are currently no plans to meet in person as the Chair hopes most of the Committee work can be done via e-mail. Below are synopses of the work done in regard to the Committee's charges for 2006/2007.

A. Systematically review the Committee's Web site.

The *Committee on Diversity* Web site <http://library.ucsc.edu/laucdiversity/> has been dormant for nearly two years and has not lately been an effective resource. Committee members have reviewed the site and recommended some basic clean-up including the removal of broken links and the updating of information about the various campuses. In addition, the website is currently maintained by a volunteer from UCSC (which hosts the site). The Committee has approached the LAUC webmaster to bring the site over to the UCOP server. The Committee chair is working to identify and clean up broken links in the *Resources on Diversity* database which is again available on the website.

B. Developing content/ component checklists for information kits to be used in recruitment.

The Committee has not yet directly addressed this particular charge. However, the Committee chair has been working with the LAUC-B Committee on Diversity on a similar charge. She is anticipating this work will inform that of the statewide Committee.

C. Develop a statement affirming LAUC's commitment to and support of a more diverse workforce in the UC libraries.

Committee members have been reviewing language at other institutions for examples of the types of statements which LAUC might want to emulate.
