Additionally, the Executive Board has begun planning for new content on the website that will showcase the activities of LAUC members and be directed towards an audience of non-members as well as members.

The LAUC Web Review Ad Hoc Committee will report to the LAUC Executive Board with an assessment of the current site and recommendations for improving functionality and architecture to accommodate both old and new content.

- Assess scale and scope of a project to implement any recommended information architecture and platform changes.
- Consult with LAUC and UCOP colleagues and website design experts as appropriate.

• Committee work will begin as soon as possible after committee formed. A report should be submitted to the LAUC Executive Board no later than February 6, 2014.
