LAUC Presentation Grant Request

Introduction: This is a request for a presentation grant for me to present a paper at the International Symposium on the Cooperation among Libraries for East Asian Resources and Chinese Newspaper Digitization. The symposium held from October 24-27, 2010 in Changsha, China is jointly hosted by Changsha Municipal People's Government, Society for Chinese Studies Librarians (North America), as well as European Association of Sinological Librarians, and is sponsored by Hunan Green Apple Data Center, Stanford University East Asia Library, Berlin State Library East Asia Department, NHN Corp in Korea, and Changsha Kaifu District People's Government. My paper is entitled ""Chinese E-resource Licensing in University of California" presented on Tuesday October 26, 2010 from 11:20-11:40am.

a. Summary and current status of the research project/activity

As Chair of the UC East Asian Bibliographers' Group, I have worked extensively with CDL, UC East Asian librarians, and vendors on licensing Chinese e-resources, including Chinese newspaper databases. I also chaired UC East Asian Electronic Resources White Paper Task Force, which developed the Chinese e-resource cost sharing model. Consortia acquisition of e-resource has become an increasing trend not only in North America, but internationally. My experience in chairing these two groups has provided me first-hand knowledge in consortia licensing of Chinese electronic resources, the advantages, the obstacles, the various cost sharing models, etc.

The presentation grant funds would cover part of my airfare and ground transportation to the symposium. All symposium-related expenses (including lodging, meals, and local transportation to/from the conference site) are covered by the symposium with financial support from the Green Apple Data Center.

e. Abstract of the paper or poster for presentation

Chinese E-Resource Licensing in University of California

As libraries face difficult budget time, consortia purchase of e-recourses has become more and more prevalent. My presentation will introduce the advantages and the obstacles to consortia purchase as well as various cost sharing models.

Chinese e-resources have seen exponential growth in recent years. They have enabled Chinese studies scholars to do research in a way unimaginable before. To meet the needs of the Chinese studies scholars in North America, librarians have to work with vendors to come up with a financially feasible licensing model. Chinese vendors want to apply the same fees they charge libraries in China to North American libraries. Considering the size of user groups for the e-resources in China so vast different from that in North America, the paper argues for a more reasonable consortia purchase model for East Asian libraries in North America.

UC as one university has established policies on consortia purchase licensing. Examples of some of the deal breakers include governing laws, permission for interlibrary loan, and course reserve. CDL plays an important role in negotiating license and coordinating payments. Chinese studies librarians usually play the role of chief negotiator for Chinese eresources because of language expertise and cultural background.

Various cost sharing models for Chinese e-resources in UC are illustrated in the historical context. The pros and cons of each model are analyzed for future directions. The final goal is to achieve a sustainable and fair consortia purchase model while meeting the needs of UC Chinese studies scholars.
