## **Annual SCLG Report, September 2016 – August 2017**

For this report, I will accord a section to each of our most pressing issues and provide a summary of our decisions.

### **JSC Cost Share Model**

The Cost Share Model Proposal is an internal UC document and will not be posted publically. [Each member](#) of SCLG will share and discuss it with their colleagues. This proposal is an attempt to 1) create one easily understood model in place of many and that is justifiable, easy to explain the rational to others; 2) be more predictable; 3) remove outdated formulas like “historical spend;” and 4) create something that is easy to use, efficient, and scalable. There is an acknowledgement about the affordability of implementing this model for some of the campuses as well as general concern over the rising cost of Tier 1s. Thus SCLG is working on a phased implementation plan and has recently begun work on reviewing our Tier 1s to see if any cancellations or other reductions can be made.

### **License Negotiations**

Mihoko Hosoi, Assistant Director for Systemwide Licensing at CDL, sends out a monthly or bi-monthly Licensing Update which I share with the LAUC Exec Board.
