PROLOGUE

One of the early resolutions adopted by the San Francisco Division, U.C. Librarians Association, called for publication of a "librarians' handbook," to help in the orientation of newly appointed UCSF librarians and to serve as vade mecum for incumbents. This loose-leaf booklet is a first attempt to respond to the need expressed in that resolution.

The Handbook Committee accepted the administrative suggestion that all handbook personnel references mention librarians only, whether or not a particular information item has broader scope. Librarians who wish to determine whether any given information applies both to staff personnel and to librarians are asked to consult the <u>Staff Personnel Manual</u> or to ask about the specific case in the Librarian's Office.

Suggestions and information for new and revised sections of this handbook are expected to be a matter of continuing Committee business.
