- 1. Prior to implementation, the initial responsibilities of this working group include:
 - Write a detailed project scope statement including:
 - Key deliverables
 - o Requirements

- o Wish-list features
- A timeline for the project
- o Determine costs and timeline related to migration
- Obtain estimates from outside consultants for website development
- Oversee engagements with outside vendors or contractors, if used
- 2. During implementation, the working group will:
 - Design and build a new LAUC website in Drupal. (Aspects of the Drupal site, including its design, or the entire site build, may be contracted out, in which case the working team will oversee that work.)
 - Coordinate training for users who will be migrating or developing content on the new site.
 - Update web maintenance best practices for LAUC members to suit the capabilities and limitations of Drupal.
 - Propose revisions to LAUC Website Policies and Procedures (<u>http://lauc.ucop.edu/about/wwwpolicy.html</u>).

Timeframe:

- Committee work will begin as soon as possible after committee formed.
- Target timeline is as follows:
 - May 27 Ad Hoc charged
 - o June 30 RFP distributed to consultants
 - o July 11 consultant proposals due
 - o July 21 selection of consultant
 - August 1 design phase
 - \circ October 1 migration phase
 - o November 1 testing phase
 - December 1 launch live site
- Committee will report regularly to LAUC President and LAUC President-Elect.
