Original Abstract as Submitted:

I would like to apply for a statewide presentation grant. I am participating in a panel presentation at the 2017 Association of College & Research Libraries (ACRL) Conference held in Baltimore, Maryland in March 22-25, 2017. The title of the panel is "Navigating to a Sustainable Future: Academic Libraries and the Triple Bottom Line." I will be co-presenting with librarians from UC San Diego, UC Irvine, and SUNY Buffalo. The description is: New strategic approaches are needed in order to position libraries as sustainable, socially responsible leaders. By holistically addressing three corporate sustainability dimensions (economic, environmental, and social), libraries can positively impact their bottom-line. Panelists will demonstrate how academic libraries play a crucial role in institutional transformative change. Recognizing economic incentives gained by streamlining operations, reducing carbon footprints, and ensuring an equitable, socially just workplace environment, empowers libraries to justify and embed sustainable values into their organization.

My portion of the presentation will be based on work we have done at the UC San Diego Library with the ClimateQUAL Implementation Group and the Environmental Sustainability Group. This topic is relevant not only to my campus, but it ties in to UC system goals and strategic plans related to diversity/inclusion and sustainability.

Our goal is to have attendees understand the concept behind the "triple bottom line" in order to apply it to the sustainability of libraries; gain knowledge of sustainability across the areas of environment, sociocultural, and economic, in order to implement best practices and new strategies at their own institutions; and develop a keener awareness of local and global sustainability issues and trends in order to develop strategic plans that both enhance and ensure the sustainability of libraries for current and future generations.

During this fiscal year, I plan to attend the ACRL Conference and the ALA Annual Conference in Chicago in June. Two out-of-state conferences will eat up my professional development budget, so I'm looking for some extra funding to help
